#### Need-Based Aid: BISON Fund

Families new to our school as well as current families not receiving BISON can now apply for scholarships for the 2024-25 school year. To start the process, families can complete a preapplication form online at <u>http://bisonfund.com/ou</u> <u>r-scholarships</u>. The deadline is March 15, 2024. Scholarships are awarded using a lottery system from all submitted pre-application forms and all applicants will be notified of lottery results via email on March 16<sup>th</sup>.

They will open the requalification process for current families on February 21<sup>st</sup> by sending them an email with the renewal link in it. They will automatically grandfather siblings into the BISON Fund. The deadline for requalification is April 15<sup>th</sup>. Just a reminder from the "Safe Environment Office" of the Diocese of Buffalo that they recently updated all Diocesan VIRTUS records for people who appear to not be participating in the monthly VIRTUS training bulletins.

If you have not been reading your training bulletins, you may have been marked as no longer meeting the minimum requirements established by the Diocese for people who work with youth. You will no longer have access to the online training bulletins until you take the necessary steps to unsuspend your account. Please call the school office if you need to begin this process.



























