If you are choosing to pay your tuition up-front for the coming school year, you should pay the school directly by **August 1, 2026** or register on FACTS for a month that is convenient to have your tuition deducted.

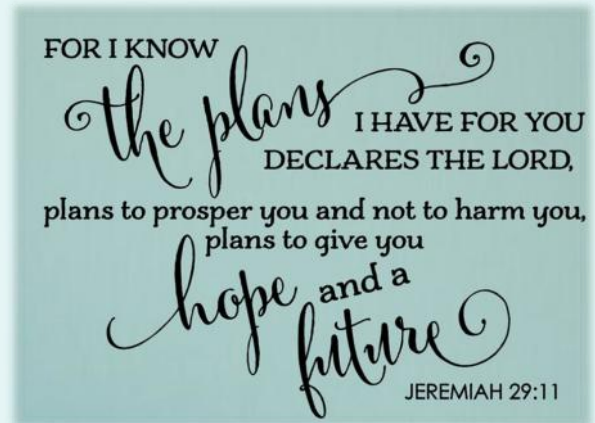


## 6th Grade Cap & Gown Fee

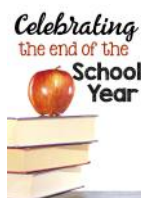

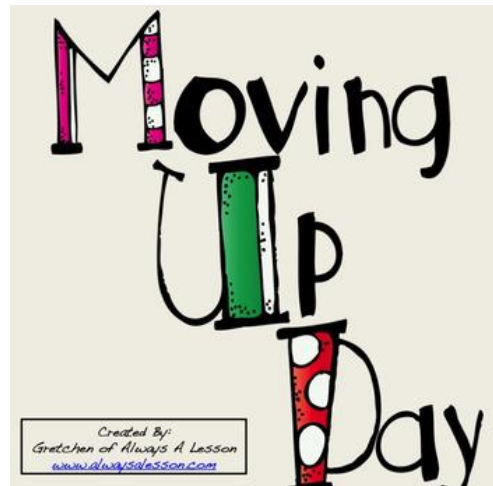

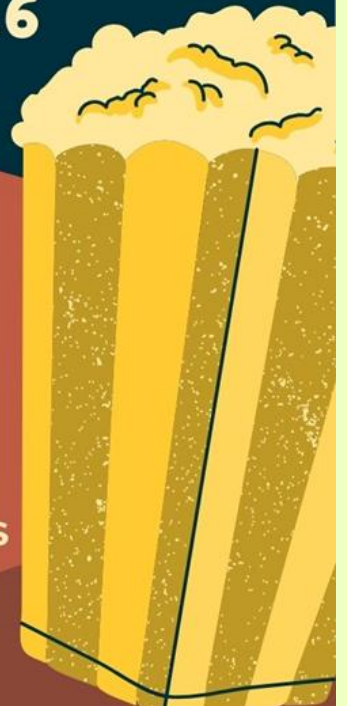
